Notes/Methodology

1. All plants were bred by Bryan Dodsworth in his garden at The Old Rectory, East Bridgford, Nottinghamshire.
2. There are 38 varieties included in the proposed National Collection. Two of these (Arctic Tern and Sullom Voe) will be added once they have been identified after flowering in June 2015. All NC plants are located in beds O/P/Q on the Marshgate Garden Plan.
3. Beds O/P/Q also contain some further plants removed from the Old Rectory which once identified reliably will be added to the National Collection in future.
4. Each Variety in beds O/P/Q have been re-labelled using pre-numbered sheep tags securely anchored in the ground. This is described as the Marshgate Plant Ref.
5. The Marshgate Garden Plan shows seventeen iris beds. There is a comprehensive manual record of the planting plan for each bed.
6. Each iris has been allocated a Original Plant No as part of a process which involved all irises within the Old Rectory garden being numbered and labelled. They were then photographed.
7. Accession Numbers have been allocated to each plant within the National Collection.
8. The registration date is that shown on the Registration form issued by the American Iris Society (AIS) which handles worldwide iris registrations.
